

The martial artists who had been kicked out of the restaurant clenched their teeth and










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climbed to their feet.

So once the martial artists had gone into the rainforest, any injuries and deaths were attributed to one's lack of prowess and the killer would not need to take any responsibility for it.


Lv Hua had to hold his temper in for now. He had to wait until they were all within the rainforest first.

"Were those fellows really that incredible?










