As usual, Penny, Frida, and Marcus were taken aback by Nathan's remarks as well. They exchanged glances as they tried to figure out what Nathan was up to.


Before long, everyone returned to their senses because they realized Nathan was merely returning the favor. After all, Victor had previously demanded a ten-billion compensation from Penny.

"Mr. Reilly, please." Winston brought two underlings with him to escort Sky back to his place.


"Thank you," Sky expressed his gratitude.

Winston sneered and held on to the dagger firmly. He was about to slit Sky's throat and send him to hell.


Bang!

As one of Lucifer's strategists, Sky was an extremely intelligent man. And given he had been by Lucifer's side for years, he knew well what Lucifer was up to.



Once Sky killed Winston, he did not hesitate to take aim at the other two men in the car and killed them both before they could figure out what was going on.


As the driver was killed, the car went out of control and ran into the flower bed by the road.

Since Lucifer intended to kill him, Sky hesitated no more and decided to turn his back against his former master.






Most of the hotel's guests took notice of the trio as t they went in and out of the hotel.

The person leading the party was surprised the moment he detected Penny's presence. His eyes gleamed as he greeted playfully, "Hey! You're Penny, right?"


Penny was dumbfounded. It took her quite some time to recognize the man in front of her. "You're Randy?"

"I'm here with my colleagues for a company trip. What about you? Why are you here?" Penny asked in return.


"I'm here with a few of my subordinates for work. I'm currently a senior officer of the North Army and we're here on a mission," Randy replied in an enigmatic manner.

The moment she finished her sentence, she was reminded of her husband because Nathan had reached the rank of a general before he even turned thirty.


She had a bright grin thinking of her husband; she was so proud of him that she couldn't hide her emotions.

Although I'm a thirty-year-old colonel of the North Army, I'm still single. To be honest, I'm quite embarrassed because of that."


"Does that mean you have yet to get married, Randy?" Penny was shocked.

Consequently, Penny, Kylie, Frida were rendered speechless by the man's reply.



Everyone turned around and saw Nathan walking into the hotel with Colin and the rest of his party by his side.





He teased with a skin-deep smile, "Hey, you're Penny's husband?"


"Yes. That's me," Nathan replied nonchalantly.

Immediately, Randy scoffed, "Does that mean you're an ordinary employee? Do you really think you deserve Penny? Look at




the differences between you and Penny.

However, Colin got ahead of him and broke the silence in a callous tone. "You're the captain of the General of the North's personal bodyguards? If that's the case, who the hell am I?"


Once again, Randy was confused by Colin's words. He found Colin absurd and unreasonable, and he couldn't possibly be bothered by Colin's identity.




Nathan looked at Randy and repeated himself, "It seems like you really have no idea who I am, huh?"

general, you'll be the only one who gets to stand by my side!"


Penny was about to say something when Nathan got ahead of her and replied scornfully, "Oh? The wife of a general? Are you serious? Is that like a big deal?"

words. At the same time, he became a little anxious because Nathan called him a liar.


However, he tried his best to calm himself down and put on a strong front. He looked at Nathan with a smirk on his face.



Randy sneered, "You really think of yourself as the General, don't you? Who are you trying to kid?"


Nathan instructed Colin, "Call Patrick. He's in charge of Bossania City's military district. Tell him to come and meet me in ten minutes."


Randy glanced at his watch and sneered, "It's been nine minutes, and I don't see a single shadow from the troops..."

Patrick led the group and walked coolly into the hotel, stopping in front of Nathan.


Patrick roared, "Attention! Salute!"

Randy looked at Nathan in horror. He had thought Nathan was a liar, just like himself.


He was so startled that his blood pressure shot through the roof.


