
Nathan chuckled. "You'd have to ask if my people are okay with your terms."

If all their crimes were discovered, they would be killed, and even if their lives were spared, they would still be sentenced to life imprisonment.



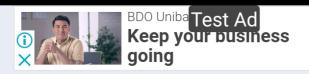

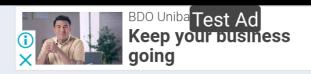
Nathan grinned, "Colin is an admirable warrior and a great superior to his subordinates. He worked hard and accomplished all that on his own, so you should be proud of him."

The Dunne family had never been this famous.

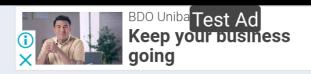
Many distant relatives of the Dunne family also dropped by to appease them.

"I'm not ambitious and will be satisfied if I get promoted by just one more rank."

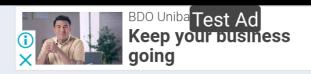
Colin smiled. "Work hard. I'm sure the opportunities will come."

was sending, so the former said, "What are you talking about, Lewis? I don't get it."



However, Hayden would never




compromise.

The crowd was dumbfounded, especially Hayden and his subordinates; they were so shocked that their eyes bulged.


Commanding officer?

But why was Franklin Wilson, the colonel of Channing military districts, addressing Nathan as their commanding officer?


Nathan let out a chuckle. "Franklin, what brings you here?"

Hayden was thunderstruck by his words. His face turned ashen, and his eyes began to fill with horror and despair.


He looked at Nathan in disbelief as he stammered, "He... He... He is a general?"



Nathan raised his brow when he heard Hayden claim he was the son of Yanis Howard.



To his surprise, Yanis's son, Hayden, was the one who ran into his line of fire before he could even meet Yanis.



Hayden was extremely embarrassed; he wished the ground would swallow him up.


Soon, Hayden and his men were taken away by Franklin and his subordinates.

He had just received a call from Franklin, asking him to go to Channing to retrieve his son.


Without hesitation, he made a phone call to the Channing military districts. Franklin

Yanis apologized for his failure in teaching his son and implored Franklin to let his son off by promising that he would discipline his son.



Colin and the Elite Eight was carrying out Nathan's order to come and pick Yanis.





On their way to Channing, they were flanked by Colin and the Elite Eight.


Yanis began to feel uneasy.

Hayden arrived at Channing military districts in the afternoon.


Meanwhile, Nathan was enjoying afternoon tea with Franklin in the office.

Nathan shifted his gaze on him and narrowed his eyes as he scrutinized him. "Senior Colonel Howard, take a seat and have some tea."


"Thank you, General Cross!" Yanis answered hurriedly, sitting on the edge of his seat.

the storm.


He braced himself before breaking the silence, "General Cross, Major-General Wilson, I'm here for my son..."

From Yanis's nervous reaction, it seems like their crime is more serious than we thought!


Nathan's lips quirked as he asked, "Yanis, why are you so nervous?"
